The Gents Competition Committee wish to inform members of the following rules which will apply to both the Gents Winter Alliance and the Harry Walsh Winter League for the 2022/2023 season.

## Harry Walsh Winter League (Teams of 4)

The winter league is a team competition and is open to teams of gents/ladies/mixed. The competition will be played over 6 weekends (Sat or Sun) but should Sunday be cancelled

for any reason then Saturdays results will be deemed null and void.

The best 5 scores will count for the overall result.

Play may be allowed on Friday's if more than 2 members of a team are unavailable for Saturday or Sunday. (Competition Secretary has to be notified in advance by a team member otherwise the score will not be entered)

In the event of ties the winners will be decided by countback on their previous best 4 scores. Prizes will be awarded to the teams who finish  $1^{st}$ ,  $2^{nd}$  and  $3^{rd}$  overall and best Ladies team.

A weekly prize will also be awarded to the team with the highest score each week (teams can only win a weekly prize once and if they feature in the overall results their weekly prize is allocated to the next team not featured in the overall results)

Each team is allowed 1 sub. The sub may be used only 3 times over the 6 weeks and must be the same person on each occasion. (Teams must advise the Competition Secretary in advance when a sub is playing)

Competition fee is  $\leq 120$  per team and must be paid into the office prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> round. (Any scores submitted prior to the payment of the competition fee will be disregarded)

## Allocation of points

The winning team on each weekend will be awarded 20pts,  $2^{nd}$  place – 19pts and so on. Where teams tie for  $1^{st}$  place the team with the better back 9 will be awarded the 20pts with the other team 19pts. Ties for all other places will receive equal points.

Note: These rules replace and supersede all previous rules
